

Immunization Requirements for School Entry - 2010-2011

Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DtaP): 5 doses required; TdaP booster dose required at 7th grade unless less than 2 years since last Td.

Poliomyelitis (IPV/OPV): 4 doses required.

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR): 2 doses required.

Hepatitis B: 3 doses required [through grade 10]

Varicella (Chickenpox): 2 doses required for Kindergarten and 1st grade; 1 dose for grades 2-10 unless history of chicken pox is documented by a licensed physician. 2 doses are currently recommended for all ages by the ACIP.

Haemophilis Influenza Type B: 3 doses required for children less than 5 in early childhood programs

Pneumococcal Conjugate (PCV7): 4 doses required for children less than 5 in early childhood programs

Hepatitis A: 2 doses required for children less than 5 in early childhood programs; recommended for all ages

Meningococcal (MCV4): 1 dose recommended at age 11

Human Papillomavirus (HPV): 3 doses recommended for females and males at age 11 and provisionally recommended for males at 11 years of age; not required for school entry

Immunizations may be obtained from one of the following:

1. Student's physician or a nurse practitioner.
2. County Health Department. The Trego County Health Department is open Mon-Thurs from 8am-5pm and Fri from 8am-12pm. They suggest making an appointment – 743-6348. Please bring previous immunization information with you for documentation.
