

Local Scholarships 2010

Agricultural Future of America - \$3200 Scholarship, \$1000 to attend AFA Leadership Conference, November 6-9, must attend fall of freshman year. Must have a 3.00 or above GPA, pursuing a 4-year degree in agriculture, application, essay, and interview. Application available on line at www.agfuture.org or from the TCHS Guidance Office. Application and essay due to Guidance Office by **April 1st**. Interview to be scheduled later. Strong emphasis on leadership.

American Legion Post 197 - \$300 for four semesters for student enrolling in an accredited post-secondary school. Applicant must have a 'C' average/above and maintain a 'C' average in college. Selection will be based on activities, honors academics, and essay. Application returned to Guidance Office by **April 1**.

Applegate Scholarship - \$1500 and \$1000 scholarships awarded to students demonstrating scholastic achievement, character, leadership, service to school and community, participation in school activities, and financial need. Preference given to students attending a Kansas college. Application available on TCHS shared directory. Application returned to Guidance Office by **April 1**.

Arlene Eveleigh Scholarship – awarded to the child or grandchild of a Trego County Employee who plans to attend a junior college or vocational-technical school. To be eligible student must be a resident of Trego County. The \$400 scholarship will be divided equally among the eligible recipients. Return application to Guidance Office by **April 15th**.

Baughner/Morton Scholarship - \$1000 awarded to a senior who has a 4.00 GPA after 7 semesters, attended Trego Community High School all four years, and enrolling in the fall at an accredited institution of post-secondary education. Return to Barbara Morton no later than **March 15**

Class of '52 Scholarship - \$1000-\$1500 to a TCHS seniors attending a 4-yr university or college in the United States. Awarded to a student demonstrating scholastic achievement, character, leadership, service to school and community. Application available on TCHS shared directory. Application, academic resume', essay and transcript due in Guidance Office by **April 1**

Christ the King Catholic Church, King Knights of Columbus- \$500(2)
Member of Christ the King Parish

. Applicant evaluation based on church involvement, financial need, school involvement, academics, community activities, and the quality of the application. Application must be submitted to church scholarship selection committee or Guidance Office by **April 1**.

Other scholarships available to students attending a Catholic college – check with parish priest.

Clarence M. Kelley Detention Services - \$300 awarded to student attending a Kansas school with the intent to work with youth through social service, law enforcement, or human services. Application returned to Guidance Office by **April 20**.

First United Methodist Church of WaKeeney - Application available to eligible active members directly from church. Return application to church scholarship committee by **April 30**.

Fraternal Order of Eagles #3774 - Aerie and Auxiliary will award a scholarship to a senior whose parent is in good standing of Aerie or Auxiliary. Application may be picked up starting April 1 after 5:00 pm at the Eagles Lodge. Return application to Eagles Lodge by close of business **April 30**.

Hutchinson Memorial Scholarship - \$1000 Full consideration and encouragement shall be given to candidates who will attend a church-related school, and/or such candidates as may be members of the Presbyterian Church of WaKeeney. Application available at church office and TCHS Guidance Office. Application and supporting materials must be returned to the church office no later than **April 21**

Masons - Related to a member of the Masons. Check with local Masons.

McDonald's - Employee Scholarship. Check with McDonald's manager.

Michael L. Dreiling Memorial Scholarship - \$500 awarded on the basis of scholastic achievement, demonstrated character and leadership, service to school and community, participation in school activities, and a statement of financial need. Application available on the TCHS Shared directory. Return to TCHS Guidance Office by **April 1**.

Nancy Scott Memorial - Awarded to a student on the basis of scholastic achievement, demonstrated character and leadership, service to school and community, and participation in school activities. Those applicants demonstrating a sincere desire to pursue a career as a professional educator will receive special consideration. Application available on TCHS shared directory. Application must be returned to the TCHS Guidance Office by **April 1**

Odd Fellows Scholarship - \$500 to be disbursed \$250 per semester for the first year. Awarded to a student or current resident of Trego County attending a college or vo-tec in Kansas. Application may be picked up at TCHS Guidance Office or by calling 743-2760 and must be returned by **April 21st** to one of the above.

Pat and Goldie Gardner - \$1500 (2) Scholastic record and potential, leadership abilities, character, responsible involvement in school and community activities, two letters of recommendation, essay. One scholarship to any accredited school, one to senior attending FHSU. Application available on the TCHS shared site. Application must be returned in to the Guidance Office by **April 15**.

Pugh/Rhoden Scholarship - \$500 to a senior attending Fort Hays State University who demonstrates the qualities of leadership, scholarship, citizenship, and service. Return to Guidance Office by **April 16**.

Roberts L. Lander Memorial Scholarship - \$500 to TCHS graduating senior and active in Ogallah Christian Church activities. Must demonstrate responsible involvement in school, community, and Christian activities. Essay and letters of recommendation. Return to Guidance Office by **April 18**.

Shaw Family Scholarship – Awarded on the basis of scholastic achievement, demonstrated character and leadership, service to school and community, participation in school activities, and a statement of financial need. Preference will be given to a student majoring in some phase of journalism Application available on TCHS shared directory. Return to TCHS Guidance Office by **April 1**.

TCHS Alumni - based on Good Citizen Award. Voted on by the teachers.

Trego County Attorney/Law Enforcement Scholarship Fund - TCHS graduating seniors who have demonstrated good citizenship and service to others in the school and community. Scholarship will be awarded the second semester of the college year after the student provides proof maintaining a C or better average the first semester. Essay required. Higher amount possibly awarded to those pursuing a career in criminal justice and/or demonstrated citizenship and service to others. Application available on TCHS shared directory. Application must be returned to the Guidance Office by **April 15**.

Trego County Education Association - \$500 Based on GPA, extra-curricular activities, honors, community or civic involvement, statement of “What an Education Means to Me”. Application available on the TCHS shared directory. Application due in Guidance Office by **April 1**.

Trego County 4-H Development Fund – Must be a member of a Trego County 4-H Club. Eligible candidates should receive application from the Trego Extension Office. Must submit application, permanent 4-H record, and 2 letters of reference. Deliver to Trego County Extension Office by **March 15**

Trego Hospital Endowment Foundation - Loans to a person interested in pursuing careers in the health care professions. Loans may be forgiven if contract to work at Trego Lemke Hospital or some other approved health care provider in Trego County. Return to Guidance Office by **April 21**.

Trego WaKeeney State Bank - Financial need, scholastic ability and record, character, sense of responsibility civic, school and church interest. Applications must be returned to the Guidance Office by **May 1**.

WaKeeney Harmony Club - \$300 Music major, recommendation from music instructor, taped or personal audition. Application must be submitted to club president by **April 15**.

WaKeeney Jaycees - \$500 Scholastic ability and record, character, reliability and sense of responsibility, civic, and school and church interest, personal resume', short article. Must attend a Kansas school. Application available on TCHS shared directory. Application returned to the Guidance Office by **April 25**.

WaKeeney VFW – \$500 Scholastic ability, financial need, character responsible, civic, school and church interest. Applications returned to Guidance Office by **April 15th**

The application deadlines are **final**. You must have all requested materials in by that date to be considered for the scholarship. If you need an extension, you must contact the scholarship agency directly.

Ask for recommendations immediately so that those writing the recommendations have plenty of time.

These are only local scholarships; continue to check the posted scholarship lists.

Think about what each organization represents. Consider what qualities a specific organization might believe important.
